MAHASKA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS March 5, 2018

The Mahaska County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 a.m. in the third floor conference room of the Mahaska County courthouse. Present were the following board members: Chairman – Henry VanWeelden; Vice chairman – Mark Groenendyk; and Member – Mark Doland. Chairman VanWeelden opened the meeting at 9:00 a.m. with a moment of silence.

It was moved by Doland seconded by Groenendyk to approve the agenda for today's meeting. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Doland seconded by Groenendyk to open the public hearing for the Mahaska County budget for fiscal year 2018-2019. All present voted aye. Motion carried. There was present a quorum as required by law. An affidavit of publication is on file with the Mahaska County Auditor. There were no written comments. Joe Warrick asked how much supervisors put into their budget for legal and what hourly rate for the attorney. \$40,000 has been budgeted; hourly rate was not available. Jamey Robinson, EMA/911 provided breakdown documentation for the combined budget of Emergency Management and 911 departments including comparisons over the past several years. Breakdown for FY2019 budgeted expenditures is EMA - \$208,976 and 911 - \$821,914.

It was moved by Doland seconded by Groenendyk to open public hearing on roofing and masonry improvements to Mahaska County Law Enforcement Centers. Drawings and estimates were available for view. No comments written or oral received. Projects will be advertised for bids. It was moved by Doland seconded by Groenendyk to close public hearing. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Meeting recessed for 10 minutes at 9:25 a.m. Reconvened at 9:33 a.m.

It was moved by Doland seconded by Groenendyk to authorize signature on agreement with Iowa DOT for use of local

agency roads for incident management temporary detour routes: T67 from the Wapello County line to IA 23. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

Paving county portion of Burlington Road was discussed with engineer. Item will be added to next agenda for possible addition to five year plan.
